RECIPROCAL ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN CLUB LUSITANO and CLUBE MILITAR DE MACAU (“CMM”)

The General Committee of Club Lusitano is delighted to announce that for the mutual promotion of friendship and hospitality a reciprocal arrangement has been signed between Clube Militar de Macau (“CMM”) and Club Lusitano.

Founded in 1870 as a private military club originally for the Portuguese garrison, is a colonial building located in Sé, Macau, close to the well-known Lisboa and Grand Lisboa Hotels.

The building underwent a restoration in 1995 when the club reopened as a private members’ clubhouse. The ground floor of the clubhouse comprises of a main restaurant, a lounge, a bar and a multi-purpose function room. The basement houses another bar with billiards, several small function rooms and a multipurpose gallery. The first floor has a conference room that is available for private dining.

The arrangement is in place with immediate effect until further notice.



Good to know-

- Letters of Introduction are not required.
- Club Lusitano Members may walk-in without reservations. However, if members plan to dine at Clube Militar please note that the main dining room can get busy; in order to avoid disappointment it is highly recommended that reservations are made.
- Club Lusitano Membership / Permitted User Card MUST be produced upon arrival, settling chit or upon request by any member of CMM management team.
- The maximum number of guests accompanied by a Club Lusitano Member/Permitted User card holder is 4 persons (total 5 including member). Nevertheless, each member and spouse holding membership cards may book up to ten pax.
- Club Lusitano members shall pay the menu price with 10% surcharge (government tax) imposed.
- The management of Club Lusitano and Clube Militar have the right to refuse or vary access on a case by case basis depending upon the prevailing circumstances.

The reciprocal arrangement does not extend to Club Lusitano members who are residents of Macau, and similarly the use of Club Lusitano does not extend to CMM members who are residents of Hong Kong. If there is doubt each host Club may seek clarification from the respective Club's office as to the status of the visiting reciprocal member. Each club has the right to refuse access.
